Biography

Henry H. Callard was the acting President of Wheelock College during the 1965-1966 academic year, and the College's fifth President. Callard received an A.B. from Johns Hopkins in 1925, an A.M. from Trinity College in 1929 and an Ed.M from Harvard University in 1938, as well as honorary degrees from Harvard and Princeton. Callard came to Wheelock with extensive experience, having held teaching and administrative posts at the Gilman School in Baltimore, MD, the Avon Old Farms School and the Tower Hill School, both in Connecticut, and the Millbrook School in New York. Immediately prior to his appointment at Wheelock, Callard served as an advisor to American schools overseas for the State Department. His association with Wheelock continued long after his term as President ended in 1966. In 1970, he was awarded an honorary Doctor of Science in Education from Wheelock, and in 1972 was chosen as interim dean of academic affairs by President William L. Irvine. Callard died in 1986.

Scope and Content

The Callard Collection in the Records of the Office of the President documents the life and professional work of Henry H. Callard, fifth President of Wheelock College. The Collection consists solely of biographical materials that document Callard's career at Wheelock College. These include newspaper clippings, press releases and memoranda, an interview in the student newspaper *The Spoke*, correspondence, and a program from the 1970 commencement where he received a honorary degree. There also two undated photographs of Callard.

Restrictions

Access:

Access to the collection is unlimited. Researchers are allowed to view all pieces of the collection. The archives is open by appointment only. Call the Reference Librarian at (617) 879-2222 to make an appointment.

The collection was the donation of Wheelock alumnae, faculty, and staff.

Processing Information:

The collection was re-processed by Jill Snyder in April of 2002. The collection was initially organized by Laura Reade and Judy Ceven. The collection was rearranged based on archival principles. Accession correspondence as well as inquiries into information from the archives was removed from the collection. Acidic materials such as newsprint were photocopied onto acid-free paper and then discarded unless the original had some intrinsic value.
